## Sacraments

**SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM** - Baptisms are celebrated every Sunday at 12:45pm. Parents are expected to attend a Pre-Jordan Baptism class. Please call the Rectory to register for a class so that we have adequate materials. Godparents and children are welcome to attend.

**SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE** - In order to accommodate our own Parishioners, only Parishioners of St. Peter (Bride or Groom) will be able to be married in St. Peter Church. Couples planning to marry at St. Peter are expected to contact the priest to arrange a date and time first. Second, they must attend the Pre-Cana Conferences as mandated by the Bishop. The period of preparation for marriage is a minimum of six months to ensure completion of all arrangements before the wedding date. For Pre-Cana reservations call 663-1373. Only Parish Musicians are permitted for Wedding Masses. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

**SACRAMENT OF THE SICK** - The priests may be called at any time day or night for the Sacrament of the Sick. Furthermore, the priests will be happy to visit the Sick with Holy Communion upon request.

**SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION** - Tuesday 12 Noon-1:00pm; Saturday 2:30-3:30pm and 7:00-7:30pm

**FUNERALS** - The proper form of Church burial for a baptized Catholic is the Mass of Christian Burial, not a service at a funeral home. Viewings in the Church are not permitted. Funeral Masses are scheduled at 10:00am. No eulogies in church, and only Parish Musicians are permitted for Funeral Masses, **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

# The Holy Family of Jesus, Mary & Joseph – December 27, 2020



## 2021: THE YEAR OF SAINT JOSEPH

On December 8 of this year, Pope Francis initiated *The Year of Saint Joseph* a year of devotion to the foster father of Jesus and spouse of Mary. It extends from December 8, 2020 to December 8, 2021 (the Feast of the Immaculate Conception). The Year of Saint Joseph has been opened to commemorate the 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Decree with which Pope Pius IX declared Saint Joseph Patron of the Universal Church.

Throughout this holy year, Plenary Indulgences will be available through the fulfillment of particular acts of piety or works of charity which the Apostolic Penitentiary in Rome has announced, and which I list below.

An indulgence remits the temporal punishment for sins and the resulting satisfaction owed to God for them. Indulgences can be either Partial or Plenary (plenary means full, complete). Indulgences are derived from the one perfect sacrifice of Christ and granted by the Church, who has been given the “power of the keys” by Christ himself to do so.

Every Plenary Indulgence always includes the following customary conditions: Sacramental Confession, Eucharistic Communion, prayers for the Pope’s intentions, and detachment from sin. For the Year of Saint Joseph, with the conditions just mentioned, Plenary Indulgences may be obtained according to the following modalities:

1. Contemplate the Lord’s Prayer for at least 30 minutes or participate in a spiritual retreat of at least one day which involves a meditation on Saint Joseph.
2. Fulfill a corporal or spiritual work of mercy after the example of Saint Joseph.

3. The recitation of the Holy Rosary in the family or among betrothed.
4. The daily entrustment of one’s life to the protection of Saint Joseph, or invoking through the intercession of Saint Joseph on behalf of those in search of work, that they may find employment and that the work of all people may be more dignified.
5. Recitation of the Litanies to Saint Joseph, or some prayer to Saint Joseph proper to liturgical tradition (see page 3) in favor of the Church persecuted and for the relief of all Christians who suffer any form of persecution.
6. The recitation of any prayer legitimately approved or act of piety in honor of Saint Joseph, especially on the occasions of March 19 (Feast of Saint Joseph) and May 1 (Feast of Saint Joseph the Worker), on the Feast of the Holy Family (December 27), on the 19<sup>th</sup> of every month, and on every Wednesday, (the day of the week traditionally dedicated to Saint Joseph).

The Plenary Indulgence extends particularly to the elderly, the sick, the suffering and all those who for legitimate reasons are unable to leave the house, and with a soul detached from any sin and with the intention to fulfill, as soon as possible, the three customary conditions, who in their own home or where the impediment detains them, shall recite an act of piety in honor of Saint Joseph, Comfort of the Sick and Patron of a Happy Death, faithfully offering to God the sufferings and hardships in their life.

Those performing the conditions for a Plenary Indulgence may apply the indulgence to their own soul or to the soul of any deceased person. They may not apply it to another living person because as mentioned above, among the customary conditions are Confession and detachment from sin. No one can perform these devotions in proxy for another living person. All repentance is a personal decision.

May the Year of Saint Joseph bring an abundance of blessings to us and to the Church.

## Readings for The Holy Family of Jesus, Mary & Joseph December 27, 2020

---

### Reading I – Genesis 15:1-6; 21:1-3

The word of the LORD came to Abram in a vision, saying: “Fear not, Abram! I am your shield; I will make your reward very great.” But Abram said, “O Lord GOD, what good will your gifts be, if I keep on being childless and have as my heir the steward of my house, Eliezer?” Abram continued, “See, you have given me no offspring, and so one of my servants will be my heir.” Then the word of the LORD came to him: “No, that one shall not be your heir; your own issue shall be your heir.” The Lord took Abram outside and said, “Look up at the sky and count the stars, if you can. Just so,” he added, “shall your descendants be.” Abram put his faith in the LORD, who credited it to him as an act of righteousness. The LORD took note of Sarah as he had said he would; he did for her as he had promised. Sarah became pregnant and bore Abraham a son in his old age, at the set time that God had stated. Abraham gave the name Isaac to this son of his whom Sarah bore him.

## Reading II – Hebrews 11:8, 11-12, 17-19

Brothers and sisters: By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to go out to a place that he was to receive as an inheritance; he went out, not knowing where he was to go. By faith he received power to generate, even though he was past the normal age - and Sarah herself was sterile - for he thought that the one who had made the promise was trustworthy. So it was that there came forth from one man, himself as good as dead, descendants as numerous as the stars in the sky and as countless as the sands on the seashore.

By faith Abraham, when put to the test, offered up Isaac, and he who had received the promises was ready to offer his only son, of whom it was said, “Through Isaac descendants shall bear your name.” He reasoned that God was able to raise even from the dead, and he received Isaac back as a symbol.

## Gospel – Luke 2:22-40

When the days were completed for their purification according to the law of Moses, They took him up to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord, just as it is written in the law of the Lord, *Every male that opens the womb shall be consecrated to the Lord*, and to offer the sacrifice of a pair of turtledoves or two young pigeons, in accordance with the dictate in the law of the Lord.

Now there was a man in Jerusalem whose name was Simeon. This man was righteous and devout, awaiting the consolation of Israel, and the Holy Spirit was upon him. It had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he should not see death before he had seen the Christ of the Lord. He came in the Spirit into the temple; and when the parents brought in the child Jesus to perform the custom of the law in regard to him, He took him into his arms and blessed God, saying: “Now, Master, you may let your servant go in peace, according to your word, for my eyes have seen your salvation, which you prepared in sight of all the peoples, a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and glory for your people Israel.” The child’s father and mother were amazed at what was said about him; and Simeon blessed them and said to Mary his mother, “Behold, this child is destined for the fall and rise of many in Israel, and to be a sign that will be contradicted — and you yourself a sword will pierce — so that the thoughts of many hearts may be revealed.” There was also a prophetess, Anna, the daughter of Phanuel, of the tribe of Asher. She was advanced in years, having lived seven years with her husband after her marriage, and then as a widow until she was eighty-four. She never left the temple, but worshiped night and day with fasting and prayer. And coming forward at that very time, she gave thanks to God and spoke about the child to all who were awaiting the redemption of Jerusalem.

When they had fulfilled all the prescriptions of the law of the Lord, they returned to Galilee, to their own town of Nazareth. The child grew and became strong, filled with wisdom; and the favor of God was upon him.
