### *Sacraments*

**SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM** - Baptisms are celebrated every Sunday at 12:45pm. Parents are expected to attend a Pre-Jordan Baptism class. Please call the Rectory to register for a class so that we have adequate materials. Godparents and children are welcome to attend.

**SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE** - In order to accommodate our own Parishioners, only Parishioners of St. Peter (Bride or Groom) will be able to be married in St. Peter Church. Couples planning to marry at St. Peter are expected to contact the priest to arrange a date and time first. Second, they must attend the Pre-Cana Conferences as mandated by the Bishop. The period of preparation for marriage is a minimum of six months to ensure completion of all arrangements before the wedding date. For Pre-Cana reservations call 663-1373. Only Parish Musicians are permitted for Wedding Masses. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

**SACRAMENT OF THE SICK** - The priests may be called at any time day or night for the Sacrament of the Sick. Furthermore, the priests will be happy to visit the Sick with Holy Communion upon request.

**SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION** - Tuesday 12 Noon-1:00pm; Saturday 2:30-3:30pm and 7:00-7:30pm

**FUNERALS** - The proper form of Church burial for a baptized Catholic is the Mass of Christian Burial, not a service at a funeral home. Viewings in the Church are not permitted. Funeral Masses are scheduled at 10:00am. No eulogies in church, and only Parish Musicians are permitted for Funeral Masses, **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

## Health Protocols at St. Peter's

Last week we were notified by the Diocese that Governor Murphy issued Executive Order 192 that impacts parish life. Most of these mandated actions are already part of the protocols previously issued by the Diocese.

As a reminder, please see a citation from the most recent Diocesan memo below:

- Workers and visitors to any office, church or school are **required to wear masks**. Those under the age of two and others for whom it is unhealthy to wear a mask must limit their exposure to others by keeping greater than a six-foot distance and minimizing the time of their visit. Workers or visitors who refuse to wear a mask may be refused admittance, **but for those attending Mass, reasonable accommodations should be made.**
- Priests, deacons and extraordinary ministers of the Holy Eucharist are reminded that they are **required to wear masks for the distribution of Holy Communion. All are to sanitize their hands before and after distribution of Holy Communion and during if necessary. One who cannot wear a mask to distribute Holy Communion should refrain from doing so.**
- Workers are not required to wear masks while eating, drinking or working at their desks **if they work in a private office.** If an employee chooses to wear a mask at all times, employers cannot deny them this option.

It has been noted that a number of people attending Mass at St. Peter's are not wearing masks. For my part, I have explained to you and to the chancery that wearing a mask is not possible for me because of my asthmatic and allergic conditions. Please feel free to receive from another minister of Holy Communion if you are not comfortable receiving from me. At the same time, those who are able should do their best to wear masks. We do not want St. Peter's to be featured in the media as a super-spreader site.

**Liturgical Changes at St. Peter's**

**SUNDAY MASSES** – Beginning November 15, we will add a morning Sunday Mass. The Schedule on Sundays will now be 7:30 am, 9:30 am, and 11:30 am. The 11:30 am Mass will be live streamed. The Diocese encourages the faithful to return to in-person participation at Mass, although the Sunday Mass dispensation remains in effect.

**BAPTISMS** – Baptisms will be scheduled on Sunday afternoons at 12:45 pm beginning on November 15 as well, with a maximum of two Baptisms per Sunday.

**6:45 AM MASS** – The 6:45 am Mass will return Monday through Friday, starting November 16. The 9:00 am Mass will remain as is.

**ADULT CHOIR** – With Diocesan permission, those members of our adult choir who are so disposed, will resume singing at the 11:30 am Mass, observing certain health protocols.

**ALTAR SERVERS** – The Diocese has granted permission for altar servers to resume their duties. Beginning the First Weekend of Advent, November 28-29, we will allow no more than three servers per Mass. Initially, we will not set a schedule. Servers may report to the Sacristy and the first three will serve that Mass. The Diocese insists on COVID-19 precautions like washing hands, etc. Servers must sign in for each Mass they serve. In all fairness, if a server has served the prior week, he or she should wait to see if others wish to serve before vesting to serve on consecutive Sundays. It will be a great blessing to have our excellent servers on the altar once again!

**WHEN TAKING A TAG FROM THE TREE, PLEASE BE CONSIDERATE OF OTHERS AND A MAINTAIN A 6 FOOT DISTANCE.**

Gifts should be returned no later than DECEMBER 13, in order for us to deliver by Pantry Day December 19<sup>th</sup>.

Our Pantry is still in need of holiday items such as cranberry sauce, canned yams, canned turkey gravy, boxed turkey stuffing, as well as our regular staple items: cereal, pasta, pasta sauce, canned soup, canned corn and green beans, brownie mix, jiffy muffin mix, canned fruit, peanut butter, jelly, cookies, boxed mashed potatoes, tuna, coffee, tea, and hot chocolate. ## Readings for the 33<sup>rd</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time – November 15, 2020

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### Reading I – Proverbs 31:10-13, 19-20, 30-31

When one finds a worthy wife, her value is far beyond pearls. Her husband, entrusting his heart to her, has an unfailing prize. She brings him good, and not evil, all the days of her life. She obtains wool and flax and works with loving hands. She puts her hands to the distaff, and her fingers ply the spindle. She reaches out her hands to the poor, and extends her arms to the needy. Charm is deceptive and beauty fleeting; the woman who fears the LORD is to be praised. Give her a reward for her labors, and let her works praise her at the city gates.

### Reading II – 1 Thessalonians 5:1-6

Concerning times and seasons, brothers and sisters, you have no need for anything to be written to you. For you yourselves know very well that the day of the Lord will come like a thief at night. When people are saying, "Peace and security," then sudden disaster comes upon them, like labor pains upon a pregnant woman, and they will not escape.

But you, brothers and sisters, are not in darkness, for that day to overtake you like a thief. For all of you are children of the light and children of the day. We are not of the night or of darkness. Therefore, let us not sleep as the rest do, but let us stay alert and sober.

### Gospel – Matthew 25:14-30

Jesus told his disciples this parable: "A man going on a journey called in his servants and entrusted his possessions to them. To one he gave five talents; to another, two; to a third, one -- to each according to his ability. Then he went away. Immediately the one who received five talents went and traded with them, and made another five. Likewise, the one who received two made another two. But the man who received one went off and dug a hole in the ground and buried his master's money.

After a long time the master of those servants came back and settled accounts with them. The one who had received five talents came forward bringing the additional five. He said, 'Master, you gave me five talents. See, I have made five more.' His master said to him, 'Well done, my good and faithful servant. Since you were faithful in small matters, I will give you great responsibilities. Come, share your master's joy.' Then the one who had received two talents also came forward and said, 'Master, you gave me two talents. See, I have made two more.' His master said to him, 'Well done, my good and faithful servant. Since you were faithful in small matters, I will give you great responsibilities. Come, share your master's joy.' Then the one who had received the one talent came forward and said, 'Master, I knew you were a demanding person, harvesting where you did not plant and gathering where you did not scatter; so out of fear I went off and buried your talent in the ground. Here it is back.' His master said to him in reply, 'You wicked, lazy servant! So you knew that I harvest where I did not plant and gather where I did not scatter? Should you not then have put my money in the bank so that I could have got it back with interest on my return? Now then! Take the talent from him and give it to the one with ten. For to everyone who has, more will be given and he will grow rich; but from the one who has not, even what he has will be taken away. And throw this useless servant into the darkness outside, where there will be wailing and grinding of teeth.'"



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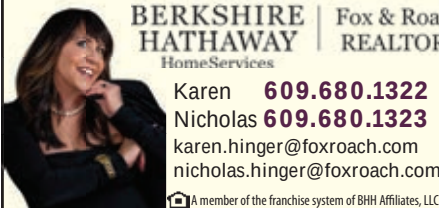
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
